Pumpkin Carving

1) One small **CLEANED OUT** pumpkin on **Thursday October** 31st. **Do not** bring your pumpkins earlier than Wednesday the 30th.

Please clean the pumpkin out from the **BOTTOM**, so that it is easy to place the pumpkin on top of string lights. Students must be able to carry their own pumpkin to and from school by themselves.

2) Please only send a child-friendly, proper pumpkin carving tool (pictured below). These can be bought at most dollar stores.

Please label the pumpkin with your child's name and division number on a piece of tape.
