### **Pumpkin Carving**

On Friday, October 31<sup>st</sup>, many General Currie students will be participating (check with your child's teacher) in a <u>school-wide</u> <u>pumpkin carving activity</u>. This activity will take place in the morning between recess and lunch in the gym.



# Students are asked to bring the following:

- 1) One small **CLEANED OUT** pumpkin on **Friday October** 31st. **Do not** bring your pumpkins earlier than Thursday the 30th.
  - Please clean the pumpkin out from the **BOTTOM**, so that it is easy to place the pumpkin on top of string lights. Students must be able to carry their own pumpkin to and from school by themselves.
- 2) Please only send a child-friendly, proper pumpkin carving tool (pictured below). These can be bought at most dollar stores. NO KNIVES OR PROFESSIONAL CARVING TOOLS ARE TO BE BROUGHT TO SCHOOL.



Please label the pumpkin with your child's name and division number on a piece of tape.

#### Costume Guidelines

We are looking forward to seeing everyone in their costumes on October 31st. Wearing costumes is completely optional, but should your child choose to wear one, we do have guidelines to remind you of so that we can all have a fun and safe day.

- Leave masks and replica weapons that may go with your costumes at home. Masks can be scary, and difficult to see or breathe out of and weapons are never allowed to be brought to school.
- Students will still be expected to go out for recess to get some fresh air and exercise, so they should be able to move freely and play in their costumes. Parent and caregivers are invited to come see our parade of costumes (or join in the parade!) Outside, at 9:10 a.m.
